- Manage data effectively using MS Office, GPS/maps, and digital reporting tools.
- Travel extensively (up to 90% of the time) across protected areas in the central Western Ghats of Karnataka, including Mookambika, Someshwara, Kudremukha, and the surrounding protected areas.
- Ride two-wheelers confidently with a valid driving license (a four-wheeler license is an added advantage).
- Maintain consistent communication with field teams, project coordinators, program managers, and the Centre for Wildlife Studies headquarters in Bengaluru.
